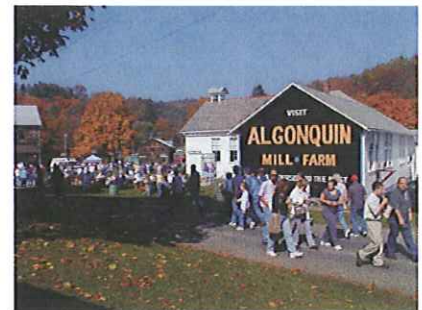

Carroll County Profile Heartland 2009

Located in the Eastern hills of Ohio Carroll County is off the beaten path. Carroll County is rural with two beautiful lakes and scenic beauty to enjoy on your drive between stops.

The visitor can step back in time with tours of the **McCook House Civil War Museum**, home of the "Fighting McCooks" of Civil War fame, **the Algonquin Mill Farm Complex** a village setting will transport you back to the mid 1800's, **Susie's Museum of Childhood at Bluebird Farm**, all kinds of dolls and toys from the 1800's to present day and **the Ashton House Museum**, reflects on retailing and 20th century history. Over 50 local artisans display their work for sale at the **Carroll County Arts Center and Gallery** located in an old feed store. Downtown Carrollton offers a family owned bakery, several antique stores an old fashioned 5 & 10, toy, jewelry and holiday stores for your shopping pleasures.

The northern region of the county is the place to find **Stone Gate Manor**, a reproduction of a 14th century gothic manor. The tour of the Manor will include the owner's story of how they taught themselves to make stained glass, to become stone masons and how they were able to build the home using recycled and repurposed wood, a true example of an eco friendly build. While in the Augusta you also might want to visit **Treasures of the Earth**, a farm dedicated to perennial flowers laid out in themed beds. There is also shopping available at **Farmgirl Finds and Manfull Farm Market**, a family run farm market with the seventh generation now involved. This area is also home to our growing Amish community.

Agri-tourism is a growing segment in the county. Agriculture is the number one industry in the county and many of the farmers starting to open their farms to visitors. Tours can be arranged at **Lana Bella Alpaca Farm, Coffee Pot Alpaca Farm, Heads or Tails Bison Ranch, Snodes Farm, Great Trail Buffalo Farm** to name a few. There is also a weekly **Farmers' Market** every Saturday morning from May to November.

Atwood and Leesville Lakes offer not only beautiful vistas but recreational activities as well. Take a relaxing cruise on the **Atwood Queen**, take a hike or go fishing. While at the Atwood Lake stop by **ALBI Winery** and try a wine or two. Enjoy a satisfying meal or stay at **Atwood Lake Resort**.
