Exhibits take you through the evolution and history of rock and roll music, from one-hit wonders to legendary Inductees, from the roots of rock to the music scenes in cities like Memphis, New York, Detroit, San Francisco, Seattle, Los Angeles and London. Exhibits explore the impact of the iconic rock stars, as well as the Inductees of tomorrow. Since opening in 1995, over 8 million people from 50 states and 100 countries have visited the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum. **New for 2012:**

Directions:

From I-71 & Hopkins Airport: take I-71 North to I-90 East to Route 2 West/Exit 174B. Turn right onto East 9th Street.

From I-77: take I-77 North to I-90 East to Route 2 West/Exit 174B. Turn right onto East 9th Street.

From I-80–Ohio Turnpike: Exit turnpike at gate 173. Take I-77 North to I-90 East to Route 2 West/Exit 174B. Turn right onto East 9th Street.

I-90 from the East: take I-90 West to Route 2 West/Exit 174B. Turn right onto East 9th Street.

I-90 from the West: take I-90 East to Route 2 West/Exit 174B. Turn right onto East 9th Street.

From I-271: take I-271 North to I-90 West to Route 2 West/Exit 174B. Turn right onto East 9th Street.

Parking:

The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum does not have a parking facility. However, our Visitor Services staff will provide you with a parking permit to be displayed on the vehicle's front dashboard. This permit will entitle you to a discounted parking rate at an area lot (\$10 per motorcoach). **NOTE: Drivers should never park the motorcoach on the street.**

Rock Hall Completes Major Redesign
